STANDARD BOAT EQUIPMENT LIST - MOORINGS UPGRADES ON FINAL PAGE*

HULL & DECK

Design made following European Directive requirements and according to EC certification
Monolithic hull design in polyester
Monolithic structural hull liner bonded to the hull
Injection moulded deck in glass fibre/balsa sandwich, covered with 'diamond-point' non-skid pattern coating
Hull-deck joint screwed, bonded and trimmed with teak toerail
Cast iron keel fixed with bolts and stainless steel backing plates*
Rudder hung with glass compound stock
White gel coat hull
Sail locker
Deck cleats at midship, bow and stern
Outboard engine bracket
Folding transom doubles as swim platform
Moorings graphics and striping
1 x Open (stainless steel) forward pulpit
2 x Aft pulpits (stainless steel)
Ring lifebuoy bracket with lifebuoy
Flag pole socket
Double lifeline (uncoated stainless steel) and (stainless steel) stanchions - lifeline gate openings to port and starboard

Self-draining cockpit
2 x Cockpit lockers
2 x Lockers in the sole of the cockpit under helmsman's feet
1 x Liferaft locker under helm seat, in cockpit bottom (0,80 x 0,40 x 0,58m / 2'7" x 1'4" x 1'11") not including liferaft)
Gas locker for 2 LPG bottles
Natural solid wood slatted cockpit seat bench
Twin steering wheel consoles: (stainless steel) wheels. Steering gear at the port helm station - metal cable transmission system - (stainless steel) handrail - gas holder
Emergency tiller system with shore power supply access hatch
2 x Steering compasses on binacle
Portside engine control and control panel
Polyester cockpit table - 2 x leaves - glove boxes - 2 x large storage spaces - 2 x (stainless steel) handrails - 12v socket
1 x Fixed composite arch with mainsail adjustment bridal system - integral lighting in arch
2 x Hinged companionway doors - plus sliding hatch
Cold shower in cockpit*
2 x Cockpit speakers
1 x Folding swim ladder (stainless steel) - solid wood steps
Folding transom - doubles as swim platform

MOORINGS & ANCHORING

Standard mast 9/10 electro-polished aluminium installed on the deck, 2 x sets of spreaders

NAVIGATION CONSOLE

Sliding, can be configured with the armchairs - Placed against the armchairs - placed against the forward bulkhead, against the galley or between the 2 x mobile seats
Table with leaf - Moulded wood trim
Switch panel on bulkhead for access to electrical functions
1 x White reading light / Red navigation lens

GALLEY
